An early list of farmers and land owners in Cartmel

A translation in progress

From an undated document at Cumbria Archives, Kendal, in one of two boxes related to the Robinsons of Fell Foot, Ref WDX1278.

Among two boxes of papers relating to the Robinson and other families and their property, there is a rental of lands belonging to Cartmel Priory at its dissolution in 1536-7. From the way the Rental has been corrected in parts, it would appear this is a fair copy of an earlier document, possibly one of several at the National Archives. For each area there are records of the various tenants followed by a summary of the area rented and annual income for it, but these do not always add up to the sum of the parts.

The document lists the King's commissioners who valued the property and appears to say it was authorised or agreed by four of the canons alive at the time. Former prior Preston was said to be given the rectory of Cartmel. Canon Fell was hanged in 1537 and canon Ridley escaped capture following resistance to Holcroft's men. Canon Willan became (or continued to be) parish priest. This might suggest the valuation was recorded before dissolution and before the Pilgrimage of Grace.

It records around 8,400 acres of land farmed by tenants of the Priory at dissolution. These rents would be paid to Thomas Holcroft, initially King's farmer of the Priory lands and subsequently owner from 1540 until he exchanged his Cartmel property with the Crown, receiving instead the manors of Over and Weaverham near his home in Cheshire.

It should be noted that not all the areas we would recognise today as the old Parish of Cartmel are covered by the land rentals. No Flookburgh or Allithwaite, other than the tithe barns, very little Lindale and possibly no Grange. Other areas seem to have little Priory land tenanted. If Flookburgh, Allithwaite and Lindale were separate manors then the Priory would have no rents from these areas but would demand tithes. At the same time how do the named areas relate to what we recognise today.? Some, such as Hazelrigg, Birkby and Quarry Flat appear to have had greater significance at that time.

Only land and the tithe barns are listed. No other property is covered. There is no mention of any type of mill or shop or burgage or other 'commercial' property.

The tenancies are measured in Bovates, a bovate being the amount of land which can be ploughed using one ox in a single season. This could be around 15 acres, depending on the quality of the land. The rent is 4d or a groat per bovate with the minimum rent for a holding being 1d, with fractions such as eighths of a bovate being charged as for a quarter.

The document ends with a 'reckoning' of three of the Priory tithe barns, at Godderside (ie in Holker Park), Flookburgh and Allithwaite. Certainly two have been assigned, in part, to commissioner Sir Henry Harrington and in part to Richard Preston (the former Prior?). No mention is made of Barngarth tithe barn. Was that retained by former prior Preston or by

curate Willan as of right and without rental? Another question is, if Thomas Bradley rented haf of Goddersie tithe barn who held the other half.

This should be of use to those looking at farm or family histories. Some family names are prominent in specific areas, such as the Barrows at Hazelrigg, Newton and Nether Newton.

Any errors in the summary translation and modern calculations below are mine. I am trying to learn to read late mediaeval Secretary Hand and abbreviated legal Latin as I go along. I think I have caught the gist of the document.

The document commences with a a preamble I've not fully worked out:
